The Marshall Fishwick Travel Grant to Popular Culture Studies/American Culture Studies Research Collections

Application Instructions:

To be considered for the Fishwick Travel Grant to Collections, individuals must:

1. Indicate the identity and location of a specific Popular Culture Studies or American Culture Studies collection and its content.
2. Provide a narrative statement of the overall focus, purpose, and research methodology of the project.
3. Provide reasons for which on-site research at this collection is needed or desirable in terms of the project.
4. Indicate projected outcomes, use or application the research project (book, article(s), completion of dissertation curriculum or course development, exhibit).
5. Include a copy of the applicant's current Curriculum Vitae.

This grant is open to both international scholars and United States-based academics. Applicants should complete the application process and submit it electronically to Endowment Director Fred Isaac at fredisaac@aol.com by no later than **January 7, 2012**. Please note that applicants may apply for only one PCA/ACA grant in any given year.
